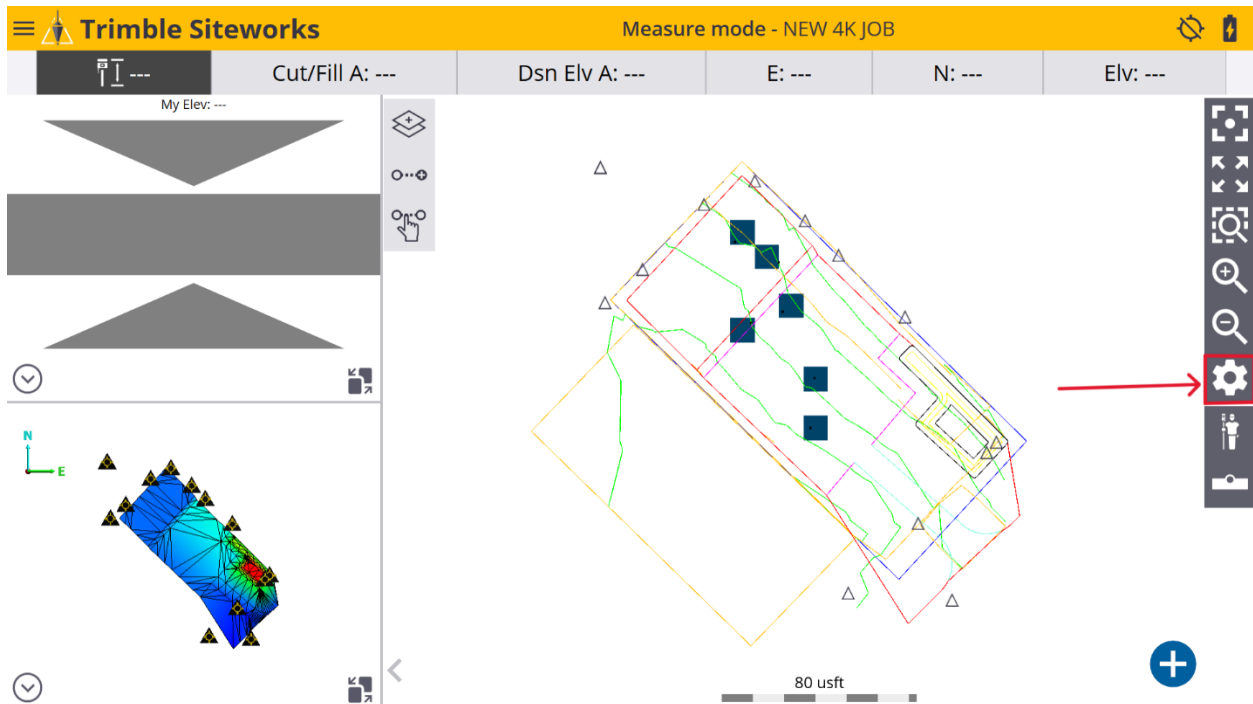




## How to Select and Unselect Layers on Trimble Siteworks

1. Tap the settings icon in the middle right menu.

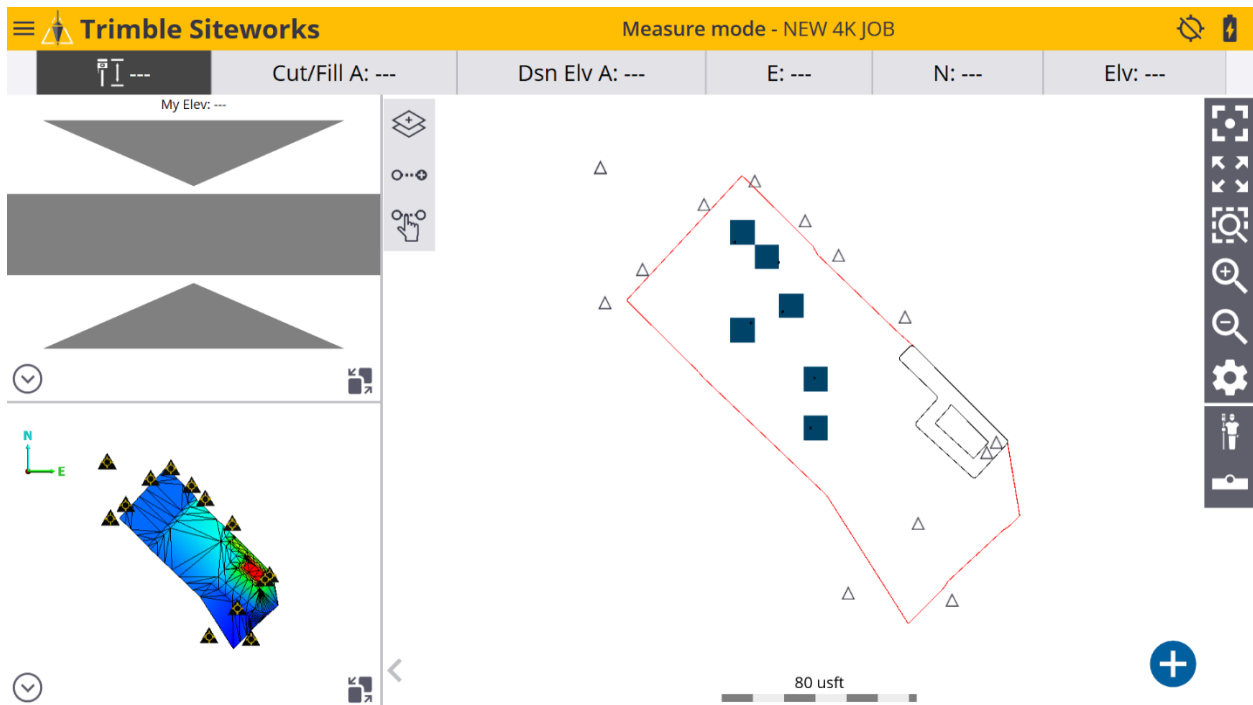
